• Our main stage shows are open to 7th-12th grade students, but those who are in Drama 2-4 perform in classroom shows as well. These classroom shows help give you the experience you need to improve and find success in future auditions.

BACKSTAGE EXPERIENCE:

• Students in Drama learn the technical aspects of theater. Some students prefer to work behind the scenes instead of on stage. All classes provide backstage instruction and *Drama 2: Technical Theater* is all about the backstage experience.
